VILLE D'AMIENS was a 7,068 ton passenger and cargo steamship built in 1924. It was owned by Messageries Maritimes, at Marseilles but managed by the Clan Line between 1940 and 1944. It was constructed by North of Ireland at Londonderry and scrapped in 1953.
