History

In 1996 Drew Ginn joined the 'Oarsome Foursome' crew replacing Andrew Cooper in the bow. The crew competed in the 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games where the 'Oarsome Foursome' won their second successive Olympic gold medal in the Men's Coxless Four final. Drew Ginn was forced to miss the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games due to a back injury. He returned to elite competition by teaming up with fellow 'Oarsome Foursome' rower James Tomkins in the Coxless Pairs. The pair came fourth at the 2002 World Championships and won the 2003 World title in the same event. They went on to win the gold medal at the 2004 Athens Olympic Games in the Men's Coxless Pairs final in a time of 6:30:76.
