### History

The THOMAS P EMIGH was a wooden hulled barquentine built in Tacoma, Washington 1901. In 1909 the vessel was credited with setting the quickest time record for a ship travelling between Honolulu and Cape Flatery, making the passage in seven days and twenty-two hours. THOMAS P EMIGH was involved in the transportation of timber between America and Australia.
