History

The MV TIJWANGI was launched in 1950 as a smaller style luxury liner. In her first 10 years the TIJWANGI operated on the Dutch Indies to Hong Kong Service. In 1960 she was rerouted to undertake the Australia, Hong Kong to

Japan service. The TIJWANGI was focused on traditional cruising with the priority being on passengers comfort, service, and as this menu illustrates, good food. She became known with her sister ship the TJILUWAH, as “Elegant White Yachts”.
