## History

In the 1930s Jewish refugees from Germany and Austria fled Nazi persecution for safety in Britain. But from 1940 when at war with Germany ,Britain came to see these refugees as potential traitors and spies. Over 20,000 refugees were interned as Enemy Aliens. Australia agreed to help Britain accommodate the internees and 2250 men were brought to Australia aboard the 'hell ship' DUNERA. They were refugees who were treated like prisoners. Only months later Britain admitted that interning refugees was a mistake and released those in British camps. The Australian Government, however, did not release many of the internees until 1942.
