Graeme Andrews OAM, grew up on the foreshores of Sydney Harbour, a regular on Sydney ferries as a school child. Andrews was a petty officer in the Royal Australian Navy and later joined the Naval Reserves. He was a Harbour Master for many years on the Manly and Sydney ferries as well as on tugs. In addition to being an accomplished maritime photographer, Graeme Andrews also found a gift for writing and became a respected journalist and editor for a number of boating magazines and the author of various books on Sydney Harbour. He continued to take and collect photographs throughout his extensive career and has donated many thousands of images to various institutions such as the Australian National Maritime Museum.
