History

SS PORT NICHOLSON was a steam merchant vessel of 8402 ton and built in 1919 by Hawthorn Leslie at Hebburn. It was operating for the Port Line Ld and used for transporting cargo including cattle. On 16 June 1942 it was torpedoed by a German submarine and sunk off the coast of Portland, Maine.
