At 9:21 this morning, we were notified that some TracPlus users were not seeing tracking data for their aircraft.

Upon investigation, it appears that an overnight server configuration change to a critical server at Satamatics in the UK caused that server to fail a routine security check performed by our firewall servers.

We have implemented a workaround and as of 10:15 tracking data was flowing again. No tracking data was lost during this time.

While all our systems remained operational, this apparent failure of our satellite service partner is being treated seriously, and we have initiated both internal and external reviews to prevent a similar occurrence and to further improve our own response times.

I sincerely apologise for any inconvenience caused. If you wish to raise any concerns directly, please call me on 0800 TRACPLUS.






