History
Sometimes called a circumferentor, the instrument was used for taking bearings on prominent points during survey work. Relatively little is known about Charles Suffell but he was listed as a general salesman at 132 Long Acre in London Directories from 1839 to 1843; then as a Mathematical Instrument Maker at the same address from 1844 to 1865. From 1866 to 1877 he was at 122 Long Acre.
