History

CLAN MACNAUGHTON was a British steamship of 6088 tons built in 1921 by Ayrshire Dockyard Co Ltd. It was owned by the Clan Line Steamers Ltd, London. It was sunk by a German submarine on 1 August 1942 while carrying bales of cotton on the trade route between Alexandria to Freetown and Trinidad to New York.
